

Guest Policy

- Members and guests must sign in upon entering the pool and identify guests to the lifeguard. Members are required to have a guest pass for each adult and each child over 2 years of age.
- Members may utilize earned guest passes or passes can be purchased for \$5 per pass. Exact change is required or a check payable to Peakland Pool is preferred; the lifeguards will not have change.
- Passes may not be carried over to the next year.
- Members must accompany guests at all times.
- Members are limited to six (6) guests per day per membership. For more than six (6) guests, please contact the pool manager or the board for approval and/or refer to the Party Policy.
- Guests within a 50-mile radius are required to utilize a guest pass. Guests who live over a 50-mile radius from Peakland Pool are not required to use a guest pass.
- In-town guests may use the pool a maximum of ten (10) times per season.
- Peakland Pool is neither responsible nor liable for accidents/injuries that their guests may incur while on the premises.
- Guests must abide by the posted pool rules.
- The Board of Directors reserves the right to amend the guest policy as necessary.

Party Policy

A party reservation is for reserving a pavillion or other area of the pool deck on a specific date and time to ensure space for a member's planned event.

- A party reservation request form must be completed and returned to the manager/assistant manager seven days prior to the requested party date. No reservations will be taken prior to opening day; however, the first seven open days are the only exception to the 7-day advance notice. *Parties can be up to 25 people (total of guests and members). To host a party for more than 25 people, you must first seek the board's approval. A list of attendees needs to be provided to the manager and all attendees must check in at the front desk. If the attendee is a member, they will still need to check in as usual.
- The member host must be present at all times with guests and is liable for their guests. ** A gathering of members does not require a party reservation, but members may not block off tables ahead of time or move other member's items to accommodate their parties. If stated actions are done, the member will be charged the party fee plus an extra \$50 fee.
- DATES & TIMES: Parties will not be allowed on scheduled home swim meets (Monday evenings). Parties are allowed only during normal operating hours, Monday-Friday, and Saturday & Sunday after 5pm (no holidays). Parties are limited to a maximum of three hours. Multiple parties may not be held simultaneously; only one party may be conducted per 3-hour slot.
- **COST:** The party reservation and rental of space is \$125 and must be paid in full 24 hrs before party. Members may use earned guest passes or passes may be purchased for \$5 per pass for non-members.
- **FOOD:** Food must be kept within the designated picnic areas and the host member is responsible for disposal of all trash. If you plan to purchase food from the snack bar facility, please make your arrangements with the snack bar management in advance. A cleaning fee of \$50 will be charged to the members' account if the area is not left clean.
- WEATHER: Please notify the manager as soon as possible if the party is canceled. If the pool is closed for inclement weather the party will be canceled and a new date may be arranged with the manager.
- For the safety and enjoyment of the membership, the party must abide by the posted Pool Rules.
- Peakland Pool is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
- The Board of Directors may amend these rules as necessary.
